

GROUNDS TECHNICIAN – SQUIRE GREEN GOLF CLUB

GENERAL PURPOSE

Under the supervision of the Superintendent, you will join the golf course maintenance team which aims to ensure the safety and accessibility of the course grounds to all users while monitoring and maintaining a pleasant appearance of the course and surrounding features by trimming, cutting, cleaning, replacing or making repairs. The Grounds Technician perform landscaping duties as well as maintenance by operating power and manual equipment and tools. This position involves customer contact and teamwork with other technicians and the Clubhouse team to contribute to the successful operation of the Squire Green Golf Club.

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES

- Ready the course for a steady flow of golfers throughout the day;
- Responsible for the maintenance of machinery (greasing, etc.);
- Cutting grass on the tee boxes, fairways, roughs, fringes, greens and surrounding trees and shrubbery;
- Install, maintain and operate watering systems;
- Sodding, trimming on and around the course;
- Pull weeds around bushes, trees and flower beds;
- Apply mulch to designated areas;
- Detect, report and control plant health and current pest and diseases problems;
- Follow golf course's maintenance protocol and safety & security policies and procedures;
- Report the overall physical appearance of the facility and any maintenance problems, accidents, injuries or potential safety hazards (sinkholes flooding, cracked or damaged paths, debris or animals);
- Performs related duties as required by the Superintendent.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- No graduation needed

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to work individually as well as part of a team;
- Good communication and interpersonal skills;
- Be tactful and courteous with the Public;
- An overriding sense and appreciation for quality, and a very strong work ethic;
- Demonstrated effective time management skills, availability to prioritize;
- Perform a wide variety of Golf Course maintenance task, be willing to take the initiative.;
- Perform tasks that require physical strength and endurance;
- Physical ability to stand, stoop, bend and kneel;
- Ability to utilize weeds trimmer, tractors, mowers, cutters and miscellaneous power and manual tools;
- Own a valid driver's license;
- English speaking, Bilingual considered an asset;
- Knowledge of landscaping machinery, parts and their functions considered as an asset;
- Understanding of the Golf is considered as an asset;
- Applicant must be legally eligible to work in Canada.

WORK ENVIRONMENT / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Duties for this position are performed in a climate heat, cold, rain, wind or other inclement weather.
- Available to work am/pm shifts, weekdays and weekends, based on seasonal demand.
- Ensure uniform and personal appearance are clean, professional and safe.
